VOTER REGISTRATION

You may need to register if:

- * You are a first time voter who will be 18 on or before November 3, 2020.
- * You are new to Rock Island County.
- * You have moved since you last registered or voted.
- * You have had a name change.
- * You have had a felony conviction but are no longer incarcerated.

Vote-by-Mail - You do not need a reason or an ID.

- A Vote-by-Mail ballot application was mailed out to all registered voters in Rock Island County.
- Visit our website or call the County Clerk's Office if you did not receive an application.
- First day ballots will be mailed out is September 24, 2020 and each day thereafter.
- Last day for the Clerk's Office to receive an application in order to mail out a ballot is October 29.
- Return postage for the ballots will be paid by the County within the United States.

Due to COVID-19, all 2020 General Election voters are encouraged to cast a ballot prior to Election Day, either by mail or during early voting. Voting by mail is an easy option for voters and you can request a vote by mail ballot through email, mail or in person. An application is available from your local election authority or at https://elections.il.gov/electionoperations/VotingByMail.aspx. To register to vote or check your registration status, visit https://ova.elections.il.gov. (10 ILCS 5/2B-30(a))
